



# High Initial Gold Results at Yilmia Project at Kambalda West

Breakaway Resources Limited (ASX: BRW) ("Breakaway") advises that recent geochemical programs at Yilmia, within its Kambalda West Project, located 20 kilometres southwest of Kambalda in Western Australia, (Figure 1) have defined several new gold anomalies with a peak spot value of 9 grams per tonne ("g\text") gold.

An initial mapping and drilling program is now being planned for Yilmia as the Company believes the results highlight the potential for significant gold deposits.

The Company expects this expanded exploration effort to commence in the near future.

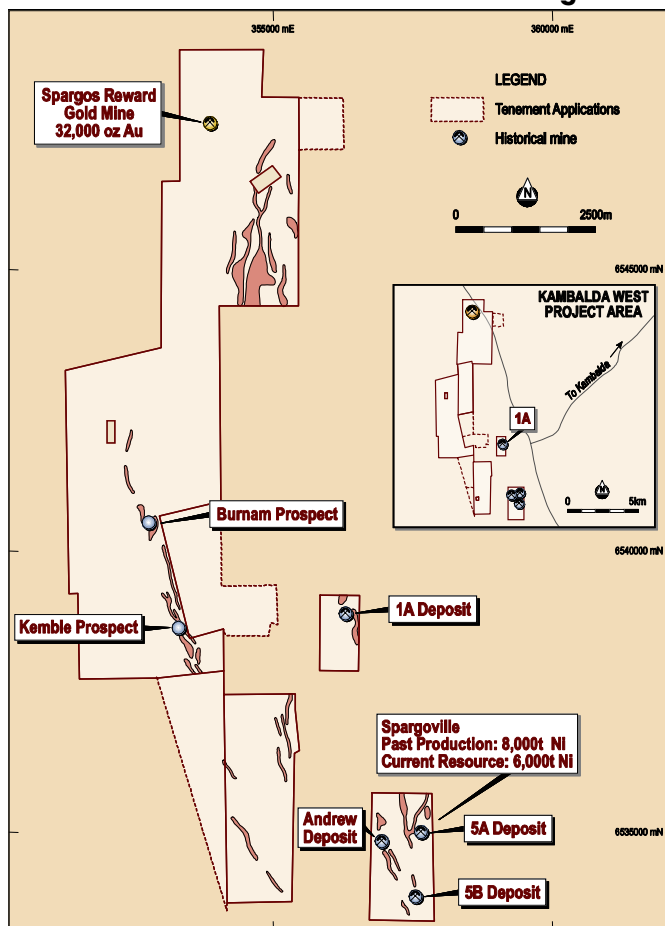
## Exploration Results

As part of Breakaway's ongoing regional exploration at the Kambalda West, a program of auger soil geochemistry has been completed at Yilmia over P15/4457-58 (the "Gilbert Option" tenements) located 5.5 kilometres south of the historic Spargos Reward gold mine. The Gilbert Option tenements cover an area to the east of the Burnam nickel sulphide prospect, and is believed to have potential for both nickel and gold mineralisation.

The initial 383 sample program at Yilmia has outlined a series of significant discrete gold soil anomalies (above 30 ppb) in the same geological setting as the Spargos Reward gold deposit. The gold results also contained five (5) assays in excess of 1 g/t gold with a peak value of 9 g\text gold. The gold soil anomalies are often co-incident with significant arsenic soil anomalism which often accompanies both gold and nickel mineralisation in the Kambalda West area.

These excellent results highlight the potential for significant gold deposits, similar to the Spargos Reward gold mine, in the Kambalda West area in addition to nickel sulphide. Following analysis of these results, a gold exploration program at Yilmia will commence in parallel with the Breakaway's extensive nickel sulphide exploration at Spargoville and Yilmia.

## Background on Spargos Reward Gold Deposit

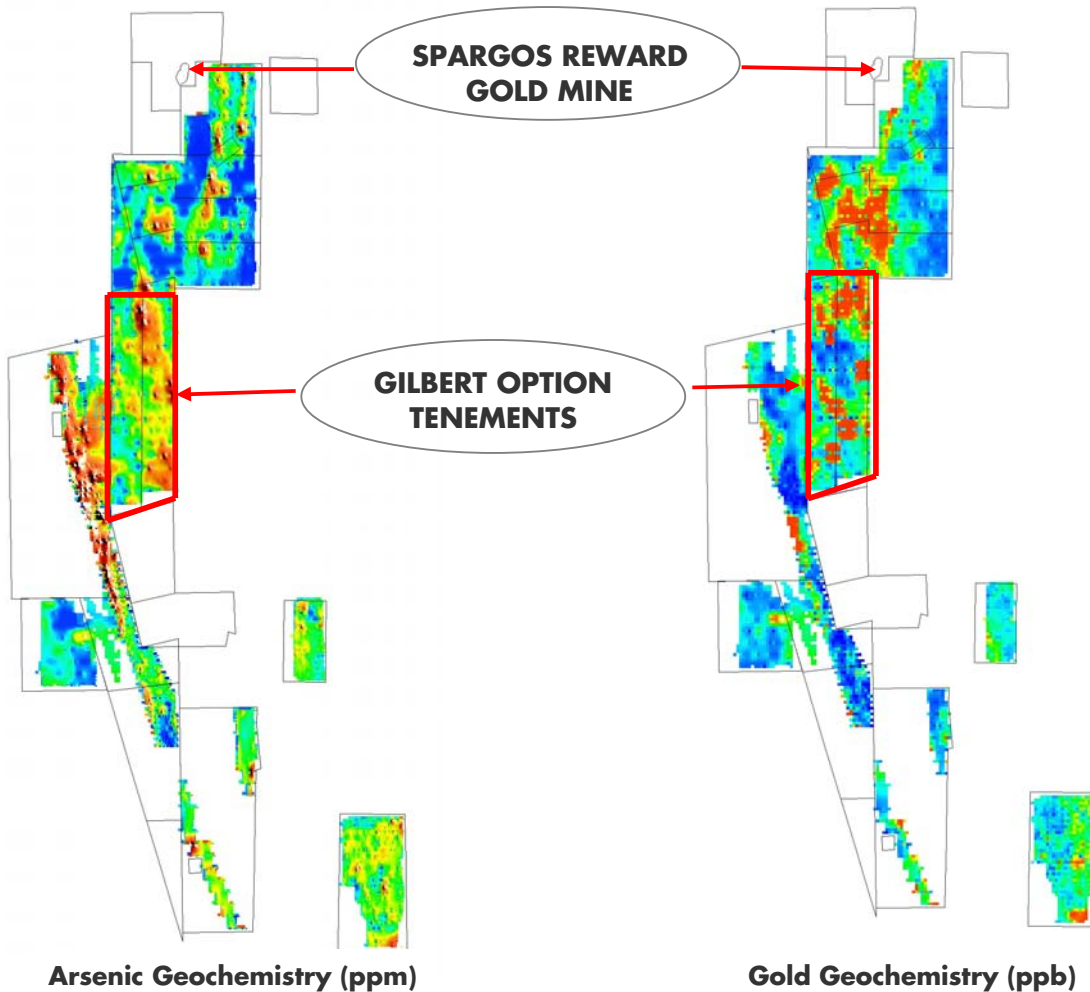
Breakaway owns 100% of the historic Spargos Reward gold mine located in the northern part of the Kambalda West Project. The Spargos Reward mine produced over 30,000 ounces of gold ( $\approx$  125,000 tonnes @ 7.4 g/t) to a depth of 125 metres. The deposit remains open at depth with previous diamond drilling intersecting significant gold mineralisation 200-300 metres below the existing mine workings (Hole SRD 2 - 5.9 metres *true width* grading 4.79 g/t from 476 metres and SRD 5 - 8.4 metres *true width* grading 4.54 g/t gold from 339 metres).
