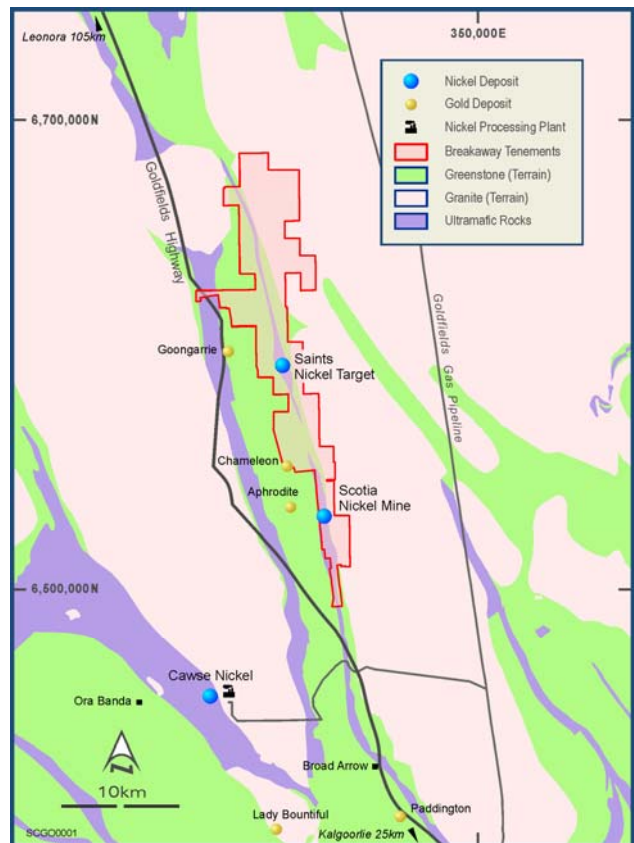
SAINTS NICKEL TARGET DRILLING UPDATE

Breakaway Resources Limited (ASX: **BRW** – “Breakaway”) is pleased to provide an update on the Company’s Saints Nickel Target diamond drilling programme.

As previously announced on 4 November 2009, Breakaway commenced a 2,000 metre diamond drilling programme on the Western Contact of its Saints Nickel Target to test for down-plunge extensions, where Breakaway has previously defined a plunging zone of “thickened” high-grade matrix sulphides over approximately 150 metres strike length to a vertical depth of 180 metres (best down-hole intercept of 27.45m @ 1.8% Ni).

Breakaway recently completed that drilling programme. Processing, sampling, assaying, and geological interpretation and modelling are not due to be completed until end-January 2010.
